Gentlemen,

The Board of Executive Officers of this Bank, in a meeting held as of today, decided to propose to the Board of Directors, in a meeting to be held on June 1, 2004, the payment to the Company's stockholders, pursuant to the Corporate Bylaws and legal provisions, of interest on own capital related to the month of June/2004, in the amount of R\$0.141180 for common stock and R\$0.155298 for preferred stock , benefiting the stockholders registered in the Company's records on that date (June 1, 2004).

Upon approval of the proposal, the payment will be made on July 1, 2004, at the net amount of R\$0.120 for common stock and R\$0.132 for preferred stock, after deduction of Withholding Income Tax of fifteen percent (15%), except for the legal entity stockholders that are exempt from such taxation, which will receive the declared amount.

The respective Interests will be computed in the calculation of the minimum compulsory dividend for the year, as provided in the Corporate Bylaws.

The Interests relating to stocks under custody at CBLC - Brazilian Company and Depository Corporation will be paid to CBLC which will be transferred to the stockholders through the depository Brokers.
