On August 19, 2002, PRG-Schultz International, Inc. ("PRG-Schultz") issued press releases announcing that the board of directors has elected Mark C. Perlberg president and chief operating officer of PRG-Schultz and that Howard Schultz, chairman, Andrew Schultz, executive vice president and director, and certain of their affiliates have entered into agreements to sell approximately \$75.7 million, or approximately 8.68 million shares, of PRG-Schultz common stock to certain affiliates of Berkshire Partners LLC and Blum Capital Partners LP in private transactions and have granted PRG-Schultz an option to purchase up to 2.89 million shares of PRG-Schultz common stock at \$8.72 per share plus accretion at 8% per annum.
