**Item 8.01 Other Events.**

On July 21, 2010, the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (the Act ) was enacted. Section 1503 of the Act contains new reporting requirements regarding mine safety, including disclosing on a Current Report on Form 8-K the receipt of an imminent danger order under section 107(a) of the Federal Mine Safety and Health Act of 1977 (the Mine Act ) issued by the federal Mine Safety and Health Administration.

On August 15, 2010, Canyon Fuel Company, LLC, a subsidiary of Arch Coal, Inc., received an imminent danger order under section 107(a) of the Mine Act stating that an operator of a diesel manlift at our Sufco mine operated the manlift without wearing a safety belt/harness with tie off lines. The manlift was immediately stopped and the operator was lowered to the ground without an incident where they put on a safety belt/harness and tied off to the compartment. These actions terminated the order.
