On October 20, 2009, UnitedHealth Group Incorporated (the Company ) issued a press release announcing its third quarter 2009 results. A copy of the press release is furnished herewith as Exhibit 99.1 and incorporated herein by reference.

The press release contains the following non-GAAP financial measures with respect to the third quarter of 2008: adjusted third quarter 2008 operating cost ratio, operating margin, and earnings from operations, each of which excludes a benefit from a change in the estimated net costs to settle two class action lawsuits related to the Company s historical stock option practices.

The most directly comparable GAAP financial measures to these non-GAAP measures are as follows:
