Discretionary Bonus Payment

On February 14, 2012, the Compensation Committee of the Board of Directors of Fabrinet (the Company) approved a one-time discretionary cash bonus payment in the amount of \$200,000 for Dr. Harpal Gill, Chief Operating Officer of the Company, in recognition of his extraordinary efforts in connection with the Company s flood recovery efforts in Thailand. Dr. Gill worked tirelessly throughout the period of the flooding to protect, salvage and restore equipment and inventory located at the Company s facilities in Thailand, including living at the Pinehurst factory for some time. Thanks to Dr. Gill s efforts, the Company has experienced a solid recovery and was able to restart manufacturing operations substantially earlier and on a significantly larger scale than the Company had forecasted.
