Payout of Restricted Stock Units. Each Restricted Stock Unit (RSU) represented a contingent right to receive one share of ProAssurance Corporation common stock, awarded under terms of, and issuable from, the ProAssurance 2014 Equity Incentive Plan. The RSUs vested

- (1) because the reporting person remained continuously employed by ProAssurance or one of its subsidiaries during the three-year vesting period that ended December 31, 2018. Vesting of 4,000 shares reduced by withholding 1,302 shares to cover the tax liability resulting from the vesting of this award.
