- (1) Reporting Person purchased the first 100 shares of Spectra Energy Corp traded on the New York Stock Exchange and contributed those shares to the Spectra Energy Foundation, a charitable organization.

- (3) On January 2, 2007, Duke Energy Corporation distributed all of the shares of common stock of Spectra Energy Corp to Duke Energy's shareholders.
