(d) The description of the Registrant s Common Stock to be offered hereby is contained in the Registrant s Registration Statement on Form 8-A filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on August 29, 1989 pursuant to Section 12(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the Exchange Act), including any amendment or report filed for the purpose of updating such description.

(e) The description of the Registrant s Amended and Restated Preferred Shares Rights Agreement contained in the Registrant s Registration Statement on Form 8-A/A filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on June 17, 2003 pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act, including any amendment or report filed for the purpose of updating such description.

All reports and other documents filed by the Registrant pursuant to Sections 13(a), 13(c), 14 and 15(d) of the Exchange Act on or after the date of this Registration Statement and prior to the filing of a post-effective amendment that indicates that all securities offered have been sold or which deregisters all securities then remaining unsold, shall be deemed to be incorporated by reference herein and to be a part of this Registration Statement from the date of the filing of such reports and documents.

The Registrant s actual results may differ significantly from the results discussed in the forward-looking statements. Item 5. Interests of Named Experts and Counsel

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The validity of the securities registered hereby has been passed upon for the Registrant by Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati, Professional Corporation (WSGR), Palo Alto, California. Larry W. Sonsini, a member of WSGR and a member of the Board of Directors of the Registrant, owns 589 shares of the

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Registrant's Common Stock. Mr. Sonsini holds options to purchase 165,000 shares of the Registrant's Common Stock. Upon exercise of such options, 10% of the shares shall be issued to Mr. Sonsini and 90% of the shares shall be issued to the applicable partnership investment accounts of WSGR, in which Mr. Sonsini is a participant.

Item 6. Indemnification of Directors and Officers

Section 145 of the Delaware General Corporation Law authorizes a court to award, or a corporation's board of directors to grant, indemnity to directors and officers in terms sufficiently broad to permit such indemnification under certain circumstances for liabilities (including reimbursement for expenses incurred) arising under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the Securities Act). Section 10 of the Certificate of Incorporation and Article VI of the Bylaws of the Registrant provide for indemnification of certain agents to the maximum extent permitted by the Delaware General Corporation Law. Persons covered by these indemnification provisions include current and former directors, officers, employees and other agents of the Registrant, as well as persons, who serve at the request of the Registrant as directors, officers, employees or agents of another enterprise. In addition, the Registrant may enter into indemnification agreements with its directors and officers pursuant to which the Registrant has agreed to indemnify such individuals and to advance expenses incurred in defending any action or proceeding to the fullest extent permitted by Section 145 of the Delaware General Corporation Law.

(1) To file, during any period in which offers or sales are being made, a post-effective amendment to this Registration Statement to include any material information with respect to the plan of distribution not previously disclosed in the Registration Statement or any material change to such information in the Registration Statement.

(2) That, for the purpose of determining any liability under the Securities Act, each such post-effective amendment shall be deemed to be a new registration statement relating to the securities offered therein, and the

offering of such securities at that time shall be deemed to be the initial bona fide offering thereof.

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(3) To remove from registration by means of a post-effective amendment any of the securities being registered which remain unsold at the termination of the offering.

The undersigned Registrant hereby undertakes that, for purposes of determining any liability under the Securities Act, each filing of the Registrant's annual report pursuant to section 13(a) or section 15(d) of the Exchange Act (and, where applicable, each filing of an employee benefit plan's annual report pursuant to section 15(d) of the Exchange Act) that is incorporated by reference in the Registration Statement shall be deemed to be a new registration statement relating to the securities offered therein, and the offering of such securities at that time shall be deemed to be the initial bona fide offering thereof.
