- (1) Reflects the withholding of shares to satisfy tax payment for vested shares of Restricted Stock Units (RSU) under the Company's Omnibus Incentive Compensation Plan.
- (2) These phantom stock units convert to common stock on a one-for-one basis.
- (3) The acquired shares reflect the portion of the vested Restricted Stock Units that have been deferred into Company common stock within the Company's Deferred Compensation Plan.
- (4) Unless the participant has selected a later commencement date, distribution of stock and equivalents will commence within 60 days following the end of the calendar year in which occurs the participant's retirement or termination of service.
- (5) Each restricted stock unit represent a contingent right to receive one share of Company common stock.
- (6) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on February 14, 2009.
Due to a clerical error, 429.5593 shares that were previously transferred to the reporting person's phantom stock unit account upon their deferral into the Company's Deferred Compensation Plan were inadvertently reflected in these holdings. This filing correctly reflects these shares being held in the reporting person's phantom stock unit account.
- (8) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on February 11, 2011.
- (9) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on February 12, 2010.
- (10) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on December 8, 2005.
- (11) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on February 14, 2009.
- (12) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on February 10, 2012.
- (13) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on December 7, 2007.
- (14) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on February 9, 2013.
- (15) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on December 7, 2006.
- (16) The option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on May 17, 2008.
Performance stock rights represent the right to receive shares of common stock of the Company, in the event certain performance goals are satisfied. These goals are based on Company performance against an established industry benchmark, over a three year performance period. The final award of shares issued can be between 0% and 200% of the target award.
- (18) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on February 12, 2010.
- (19) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on February 11, 2011.
- (20) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on February 10, 2012.
- (21) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on February 9, 2013.
